ABSTRACT

This paper entitled "Planning Programs at Maritime and Fishery Service Semarang City", is the result of field study conducted for three weeks (started from 16th February to 8th March 2006) at Maritime and Fishery Service Semarang City. This study is aimed at describing the planning programs at Maritime and Fishery Service Semarang City.

The data of this study were collected by using interview, observation, and library research methods. The interview method was conducted to get information about the planning programs at the company.
