16. **The American wife** stands in the doorway; she meets a maid who looks after her room.
17. The maid gives an umbrella to the American wife.
18. **The American wife** keeps on looking for the cat, then she gets the table; nevertheless, the cat isn't there.
19. **The American wife** feels disappointed.

#### **No. 15 – 19 → Climax**

20. There's a conversation between the maid and **the American wife** about what happens.
21. The maid asks what happens.
22. **The American wife** tells about the cat in the rain.
23. The maid laughs such as hearing an impossible thing; **the American wife** tells her again about the cat.
24. The maid asks her for going back to the room.
25. **The American wife** feels a terrible feeling.
26. **The American wife** is in her room.
27. George is reading on the bed.

28. There's a conversation between George and **the American wife**.
29. George asks his wife about the cat.
30. **The American wife** tells him that the cat is gone; besides, she really wants that poor kitty.
31. George continues on his reading with saying nothing.
32. **The American wife** reflects her picture on the mirror and studies her appearance.
33. **The American wife** wants a new hair style with growing her hair up.
34. George assures his wife that she's pretty without growing her hair up.
35. **The American wife** still wants a new hair style; however, her husband ignores it and carries on his reading.
36. **The American wife** gives an option about new hair style or the poor kitty.
37. Her husband still doesn't care and put big attention on his book.
38. Someone knocks the door.
39. The maid brings a big tortoise-shell of cat.

***No.28-39 → Falling action***

40. **The American wife** gets the cat from the maid.

***No. 40 → Resolution***

## PLOT

### **Exposition :**

### **Rising Action :**
